Earlier today, Ryerson University released a statement notifying students that all classes will be moved online as a response to the COVID-19 Virus. At this point in time, the Ryerson Students Union will be closing many of its services due to COVID-19 as well. The majority of the services that the RSU offers are frontline services. There will be limited students on campus and the Student Campus Center will only be accessible through authorized OneCards. Taking this into consideration, we will be ceasing operations of such services effective today at 6:00PM until Monday, March 30th, 2020 at which point we will reassess the situation and release another update.
