RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Oversee the daily operations of the Sexual Assault Survivor Support Line.
- Scheduling volunteers on the Sexual Assault Survivor Support Line.
- Working with and providing support to diverse communities; Successfully Candidates will have a strong understanding of how to provide community care and how this may look differently to different folks and different communities.
- Responsible for maintaining a regular schedule, providing resources, information and peer support to community members.
- Coordinate the online intake reporting system.
- Develop materials, reports, and training presentations to combat Sexual Violence, Rape Culture, Misogyny, Misogynoir, and more.
- Responsible to work and/or cover shifts on the Sexual Assault Support Line.
- Assists in updating the website with up-to-date information on the Centre for Safer Sex & Sexual Violence Support.

SUCCESSFUL CANDIDATES WILL POSSESS:

- Previous experience working to combating Gender-Based Violence & Sexual Violence is an asset, however, not a requirement.
- Knowledge and experience working from anti-oppressive, trauma-informed and survivor-centered frameworks.

- Experience with active listening, peer-to-peer support, or prior experience working on a Support Phone Line.
- Experience working with diverse communities to promote community building and community care.
- The ability to overcome challenging situations, and lead a project from concept and planning through to successful completion.
- Can work independently with minimal supervision but is team-oriented.
- Effective verbal and written communication.
- Proven ability to work within deadlines and in an expedient manner.
- Ability to motivate others and recruit volunteers.
- Knowledge and understanding in creating safe and inclusive spaces.
- Must have a strong understanding of Gender & Feminist Issues; including but not limited to Gender-Based Violence, Intimate Partner Violence, Sexual Violence, the Missing & Murdered Indigenous Women, Girls, Two-Spirited & Trans People Crisis, Reproductive Justice, and so on.
